From the South on I-5

From I-5 merge onto WA-14E via exit 1A towards Camas
Exit SE 192nd Ave via exit 10
Turn left onto SE 192nd Ave
Turn Right onto SE Brady Rd which becomes NW Parker St
Turn Left NW Lake Rd
Turn Right on NW Nightshade St

From the North on I-5

From I-5 merge onto I-205S via exit 7 heading towards Salem
Exit to WA-14E via exit 27 heading towards Camas
Exit SE 192nd Ave via exit 10
Turn left onto SE 192nd Ave
Turn Right onto SE Brady Rd which becomes NW Parker St
Turn Left NW Lake Rd
Turn Right on NW Nightshade St
